



Fee for Refraction

A refraction is a test that is performed during your eye exam. Most people that have had an eye examination remember the refraction as the part of the examination in which the doctor or technician asks, "Which lens is clearer or better -- lens one or lens two, or do they appear about the same? This test is a necessary part of an ophthalmic examination to help determine your best possible vision and to aid the physician in determining if there is a medical reason causing your symptoms. This exam indicates if any medical, optical or surgical treatment may be needed. Most major insurance companies **do not cover** charges for a refraction. Medicare is one company that does not pay for this service. The fee for refraction is \$50.00. These amounts are to be paid in full at the completion of your visit.
